

UNDERSTANDING TITHING AND THE FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Several weeks ago, Fr. Francis spent some time discussing the need for parishioners increased giving to balance our budget and meet our financial obligations.

As we look at the data in Weekly Collection you see the total tithing received from the previous weekend and also see the weekly intention amount which is \$16,000. This is the amount that is not generated from other giving areas/payments to the church that is needed to meet our weekly operating costs. When we don't get that \$16,000. we are then forced to take money from other areas which results in shortages.

This past weekends' giving amounted to \$13,770 resulting in a \$2230 shortfall. The previous week the total was \$8454 resulting in a \$7546 shortfall. The giving level that Father was asking the parish to prayerfully consider was not a request for a one week increase but for continuous support of the parish and the school. Remember, they are one and the same. There is no separate budget for the school. Per Diocesan policy, the school is a function of the parish. We have heard from a few of our parishioners that they give directly to the school instead of the parish in the weekend collection. That is NOT tithing, that is making a gift to the school and that is how it is viewed by the school. Tithing is the practice of regularly giving of one's income to the church and is deeply rooted in both the Old and New Testaments.

ENTENDIENDO EL DIEZMO Y EL ESTADO FINANCIERO

Hace varias semanas, el Padre Francis dedicó tiempo a hablar sobre la necesidad de que los feligreses aumentaran sus donaciones para equilibrar nuestro presupuesto y cumplir con nuestras obligaciones financieras.

Al revisar los datos de la Colecta Semanal, se puede ver el diezmo total recibido el fin de semana anterior y también la intención semanal de \$16,000. Esta es la cantidad que no se genera de otras áreas de donación o pagos a la iglesia y que se necesita para cubrir nuestros gastos operativos semanales. Cuando no recibimos esos \$16,000, nos vemos obligados a tomar dinero de otras áreas, lo que resulta en escasez.

Las donaciones del fin de semana pasado ascendieron a \$13,770, lo que resultó en un déficit de \$2,230. La semana anterior, el total fue de \$8,454, lo que resultó en un déficit de \$7,546. El nivel de donaciones que el Padre pedía a la parroquia que considerara con oración no era una solicitud de aumento por una sola semana, sino de apoyo continuo para la parroquia y la escuela. Recuerden, son lo mismo. No hay un presupuesto separado para la escuela. Según la política diocesana, la escuela es una función de la parroquia. Algunos feligreses nos han dicho que donan directamente a la escuela en lugar de a la parroquia en la colecta del fin de semana. Eso NO es diezmar, es hacer una donación a la escuela, y así es como la escuela lo considera. El diezmo es la práctica de donar regularmente de los ingresos a la iglesia y está profundamente arraigado tanto en el Antiguo como en el Nuevo Testamento.


